Date	Theme	Detailed Theme Description
Week 1: 6/27-7/1	Eyes to the Sky	This first week of summer will be spent expanding our senses while interpreting the daytime sky. Campers will learn common bird species found in Seattle, about weather patterns, and creatures who happily venture off the ground in Carkeek Park!
Week 2: 7/5--7/8 No program 7/4	Wild Creativity	Want to spend summer days observing the natural world through color and creation? There are no limits to what may be discovered! Using unique field journals and natural space as canvas, we will explore this colorful park. <i>No camp July 4th</i>
Week 3: 7/11-7/15	Nature Detective	This week we dig deep to understand the mysteries of science and nature. Through inquiry and investigation, we will uncover methods of the natural world! Activities will be based on campers own questions and hypothesis. <i>Includes a field trip to the Zoo.</i>
Week 4: 7/18-7/22	Wet and Squiggly Tidepool Wonders	Love the beach? This week of exploration takes campers who love the ocean to a deeper level. A week full of great low tides, we will venture down daily to uncover treasures as the water is pulled out.
Week 5: 7/25-7/29	Outdoor Explorers	Do you want to learn how to survive in our forests? This week we will learn outdoor skills including packing for an outdoor adventure, navigation, use and identification of native plants and how to make fire by friction.
Week 6: 8/1-8/5	Tidepools - Windows to Puget Sound	Campers will spend time on the beach each day, investigating the wonders of the Puget Sound. Not only seeing shoreline species with daily low tides, but also spending time exploring what lives in the water's depths. <i>Includes a trip to the Seattle Aquarium.</i>
Week 7: 8/8-8/12	Micro Worlds	Do tiny critters fascinate you? Campers will collect and study insects from multiple habitats and learn about their role in different ecosystems. We will create bug-related art, learn about insect transformation and why even humans depend on pollinator pathways.
Week 8: 8/15-8/19	PNW Timetravel	Campers will discover why Carkeek and the Pacific Northwest are so special to learn and grow in. Activities include safe identification of plants and traditional uses, learning how the Puget Sound and nearby mountains were formed, and Native American storytelling.
Week 9: 8/22-8/26	Carkeek Survivor	Join us as we follow the courageous young Sam Gribbley on his year-long adventure of surviving in the forest. Inspired by the classic book, <i>My Side of the Mountain</i> , activities will including preparing for an outdoor adventure, fire building and orienteering.
