


Construction Notice

Safety Improvements Coming to S Othello Street

June 4, 2012



Construction starting week of June 18 **Expect parking restrictions**

The Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will build street frontage improvements on S Othello Street. Work is scheduled to begin the week of June 18 and is expected to be completed by late July, weather permitting.

This project is part of the "Bridging the Gap" transportation levy approved by Seattle voters in November 2006 and funded by the Neighborhood Street Fund (NSF), a city-administered program that works with communities to prioritize and build neighborhood projects.

Project area

S Othello Street between Seward Park Avenue S and Rainier Avenue S

Project elements

- **Six-foot wide concrete sidewalk, curb, and gutter**
- **On street parallel parking**
- **New driveway entrances and connections to sidewalk**
- In addition, Seattle Public Utilities will be **upgrading the water main** on the north side of the street. This work will be coordinated with the transportation project.

S Myrtle/Othello Street re-channelization will follow completion of street improvements. The re-striping will reduce speeding and the potential for accidents along the corridor, improve safety and balance the needs of all users of the corridor –motor vehicle, bus, freight as well as pedestrian and bicycle traffic.

What to Expect During Construction:

- Typical work hours 7am - 6pm; Monday - Friday
- Temporary driveway closures (5-7 days)
- Parking, loading and lane restrictions near work zones
- Selective tree removal
- Moderate construction noise and dust
